  5. Language – Hindi or English ( English can be written online, For Hindi paper will be provided at the exam centre, after writing essay will be scanned at the exam centre and uploaded )
  6. There will be no costs on the participants
- **Prizes**
  1. There will be 4 prizes: Rs. 15,000, Rs. 12,000, Rs. 10,000 and Rs 7500, along with certificates

Sir/Madam,

To mark the anniversary of the adoption of India's Constitution on November 26, 1949, in 2015 the Government of India decided to observe 26<sup>th</sup> November as "Constitution Day" or "Samvidhan Diwas". On this day in 1949, the Indian Constitution was adopted which came into force on January 26, 1950, marking the beginning of a new era in the history of India.

The "Constitution Day" will be a part of year-long nationwide celebrations starting from 26<sup>th</sup> November, 2019, during which a number of activities with special emphasis on Fundamental Duties have been planned by UGC throughout the year, with active participation of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs).

UGC shall coordinate organising various year-long awareness and sensitization programmes through identified National Coordinating Universities and State Coordinating Universities covering HEIs in all the States and UTs, starting from the Constitution Day, i.e., 26th November, 2019, on a large pan India scale and with greater focus on Fundamental Duties.

These include National level essay competition, state level debate, mock parliament and moot court competitions. Various activities like workshops, guest lectures by eminent jurists, poster making, slogan writing and street plays will also be organized.

The 1<sup>st</sup> monthly National Essay Competition is scheduled to be held on **26<sup>th</sup> December, 2019** and the deadline for registration is **10<sup>th</sup> December, 2019**. The details of 1<sup>st</sup> National Essay Competition are available on the portal - <http://kartavya.ugc.ac.in/>.

You are requested to encourage the students of your institution to register for the National Essay Competition on the aforementioned portal. This may be given wide publicity, such as informing student heads of various clubs/societies, issuing notices and uploading information on institution's website related to registration, deadline and prizes for essay competition, so that more and more students can participate in the National Essay Competition scheduled for 26<sup>th</sup> December, 2019.


