- To apply political ideas to current political systems, ideologies, and practices.
- To develop critical thinking skills in evaluating political arguments and texts.

Course Learning Outcomes: By the end of the paper, students should be able to :

- Explain the key concepts and philosophy of major Western Political Thinkers.
- Critically evaluate the relevance and influence of classical and Modern Political Theories in today's world.
- Identify and discuss core ideas like justice, liberty, authority, democracy, and rights as conceptualized by different thinkers.
- Demonstrate an understanding of the historical evolution of political thought.

Course Objectives:

- This paper makes students able to understand the relationship between international relations and international organization.
- It seeks to equip students with the basic intellectual tools for understanding International organization.
- The course begins by historically contextualizing the evolution of the international state system before discussing the agency-structure problem through the levels-of-analysis approach. A key objective of the paper is to make students aware of the global major political events before the 2nd World War.
- It provides a fairly comprehensive overview of the major political developments and events starting from the twentieth century. Students are expected to learn about the key milestones in world history and equip them with the tools to understand and analyse the same from different perspectives.

Course Learning Outcomes:

- Students will learn about major political events in the history of International Relations.
- The paper will enhance students' understanding of the major political developments in international relations before 1945.
- Students will have a better understanding of international organizations which existed before the U.N.O.
- The paper will develop in-depth knowledge about superpowers like the U.S.A., Russia and Japan.

Course Objectives:

- The objective of this paper is to study important themes of modern political thinkers. The paper has been designed to give students a glimpse of the richness and diversity within Indian Political thought.
- The thinkers have been consciously selected to represent a wide spectrum of ideologies and vantage points within the modern Indian thought tradition. Selected extracts from original texts are also given to discuss in the class.
- This shall help students to have some experience in understanding how these thinkers build up their arguments and develop their views on the respective themes.

Course Learning Outcomes:

- The course is aimed to equip students with critical understanding about modern Indian thought.
- The thematic exploration of ideas is meant to locate the topical debates on important subjects on a historical trajectory and reflect over the diverse possibilities exhibited in the writings of the respective thinkers.
- It is expected that at the end of the course, the students will be able to think about issues and debates in contemporary India from multiple vantage points, including its historical significance in the Indian tradition.
- It would also help them develop tolerance and respect for diverse opinions and, at the same time, to admire and appreciate the plurality within the modern Indian intellectual tradition.

Course Title	INDIAN FOREIGN POLICY		

Course Objectives:

- The objectives of the paper are to teach students the domestic sources and the structural constraints on the genesis, evolution and practice of India's foreign policy.
- The endeavour is to highlight integral linkages between the 'domestic' and the 'international' aspects of India's foreign policy by stressing the shifts in its domestic identity and the corresponding changes at the international level. Students will be instructed on India's shifting identity as a postcolonial state to the contemporary dynamics of India attempting to carve its identity as an 'aspiring power'.
- India's evolving relations with the super powers during the Cold War and after, bargaining strategy and positioning in international climate change negotiations, international economic governance, international terrorism and the United Nations facilitate an understanding of the changing positions and development of India's role as a global player since independence.

Course Learning Outcomes:

- Students will learn about India's diplomatic maneuvers in an essentially interest and power-seeking global hierarchical relationship.
- Students will also learn about the challenges India faces in securing its interests as a postcolonial state.
- The study of India's ability to engage with powerful nations of the world like U.S.A. and China that will help students understand India's perspective on international relations.
- The paper will enhance students' understanding of India's strategies in South Asia.
- Students will also learn about India's negotiation strategy in dealing with global trade, environment and security regime.
