❖ About the Course:

Drama combines different elements that aim to transmit a certain feeling or inner state to the audience. This can be achieved through theatrical play, music, dance, mimic and various specific techniques.

Dance is also an art form that intends to orient and produce synchronised body movements and continuous exchange of artistic positions of the human body on a certain rhythm. Dance is strongly linked with music, emotional images and content embodiment through choreographic composition, figures and movements. Dance is used as a method of individual expression as well as a way of social communication.

Drama and dance course covers topics like: Voice and Speech improvisation, Body Movement, Theatre Games, Part of Stage, Stage and Light, Sound Technique, Theatre and Personality, Performance and Bharatnatyam, Mime and Dance Steps, Improvisation, Voice Projection, Body Language and Movements, Gesture and Posture, Pronunciation, Meditation, Pranayam and Body Movement, Presentation, Drama and Dance (Monologue, One Act Play etc).
